

EYE PROTECTION

INSTRUCTOR'S GUIDE

MODULE OVERVIEW

This module presents information on work tasks that generate exposure to eye hazards. Selection and use of eye protection are discussed. Emphasis is placed on understanding how safety glasses are labeled. Students learn how to store and maintain eye protection items properly.

OBJECTIVES

When students have completed this module, they will be able to:

- Identify tasks that generate exposure to eye hazards.
- Explain how to select eye protection for each operation.
- Explain how to determine if a pair of glasses are safety glasses.
- Demonstrate how to store and maintain eye protection devices correctly.
