

MODULE OVERVIEW

This module presents information on work tasks that generate exposure to noise and eye hazards. Symptoms of hearing loss, selection and use of earplugs and ear muffs are discussed. Students learn how to identify safety glasses and how to select eye protection for specific operations. Students learn how to store and maintain hearing and eye protection items properly.

OBJECTIVES

When students have completed this module, they will be able to:

- Identify tasks that generate exposure to noise and eye hazards.
- List the symptoms associated with temporary and permanent hearing loss.
- Explain how to select, use and care for eye and hearing protection.
- Explain how to determine if a pair of glasses are safety glasses.
